

Lower tariffs for all Romande Energie customers

Romande Energie has today published its regulated tariffs for 2013. All the customers will benefit from a reduction in their electricity bills, which may be cut by up to 3% for residential clients. This is primarily due to the measures taken by Romande Energie to hold down costs and improve the efficiency of its regional power grid.

The new tariffs published today will take effect on 1 January 2013. Romande Energie is pleased to announce that all its clients will see their electricity charges for the same consumption diminish in 2012, with households benefiting from an average reduction of up to 3%.

By way of an example, this represents savings of around CHF 22 per year (2.6%) for a household in the area served by Romande Energie with an annual consumption of 4,000 kWh and using the "Volta simple" tariff.

Stability for energy, fall of around 5% for the regional network

The price of electricity is made up of several components: the energy itself, use of the regional power grid, use of the national VHT transmission network, control energy (system services), and taxes and dues.

The 2013 price level for the energy item is identical to that of 2012.

On the other hand, the cost of using the regional power grid is 4.7% lower. This item accounts for about 40% of the overall tariff, and is the main factor behind the reduction announced today. For the second year running, Romande Energie is giving its customers the benefit of the reduction in costs and the optimization of investments resulting from the asset management policy which it implemented some years ago.

In addition, Romande Energie is passing on the decline in the price of control energy and the increase in usage rates for the national transmission network. These two items depend directly on Swissgrid SA and account for 2% and 3% respectively of a household's electricity bill.
